HEAD

With Hook no 1'25

- Row 1: MR, 2 SC in Each st (6)
- Row 2: 2 SC in each St (12)
- Row 3: SC in next St, Inc (repeat) (18)
- Row 4: Inc, 1 SC in st after (repeat) (24)
- Row 5: 3 SC then Inc (repeat) (30)
- Row 6: 4 SC then Inc (repeat) (36)
- Row 7: 5 SC then Inc (repeat) (42)
- Row 8: 6 SC then Inc (repeat) (48)
- Row 9: 7 SC then Inc (repeat) (54)
- Row 10: 8 SC then Inc (repeat) (60)
- Row 11: 9 SC then Inc (repeat) (66)
- Row 12: 10 SC then Inc (repeat) (72)
- Row 13: 11 SC then Inc (repeat) (78)

 Row 75: 12 SC then DC (repeat) (78)
 Row 76: 11 SC then DC (repeat) (72)
 Row 77: SC (72)

The Pattern calls for the body to be stuffed here in the original language version, But because of the sheer size I would suggest doing it as you crochet.

Row 78: BLO, SC 10 then DC (repeat) (66)
 Row 79: 9 SC then DC (repeat) (60)
 Row 80: 8 SC then DC (repeat) (54)
 Row 81: SC (54)
 Row 82: 7 SC then DC (repeat) (48)
 Row 83: 6 SC then DC (repeat) (42)
 Row 84: 5 SC then DC (repeat) (36)
 Row 85: 4 SC then DC (repeat) (30)
 Row 86: 3 SC then DC (repeat) (24)
 Row 87: 2 SC then DC (repeat) (18)

Continue to stuff as you crochet!

Row 88: SC then DC (repeat) (12)
 Row 89: Dec untill closed
Fasten off



Frill

Join purple on the unused loops at row 73

Row 1: 5 SC then 3 SC in the next stitch (repeat) (96)

Row 2: 6 SC then 3 SC in next point, 7 Sc then 3 SC in next Stitch (repeat Bold part 11 times then SC) (120)

Row 3: 7 SC then 3 SC in next point, 9 Sc then 3 SC in next Stitch (repeat Bold part 11 times then 2 SC) (144)

Row 4: 8 SC then 3 SC in next point, 11 Sc then 3 SC in next Stitch (repeat Bold part 11 times then 3 SC) (168)

Row 5: 9 SC then 3 SC in next point, 13 Sc then 3 SC in next Stitch (repeat Bold part 11 times then 24 SC) (192)

Change to Yellow/Gold

Row 6: SC (192)

Do a lap with "rachy Step" all around (video). Finish. Cut and hide the thread.

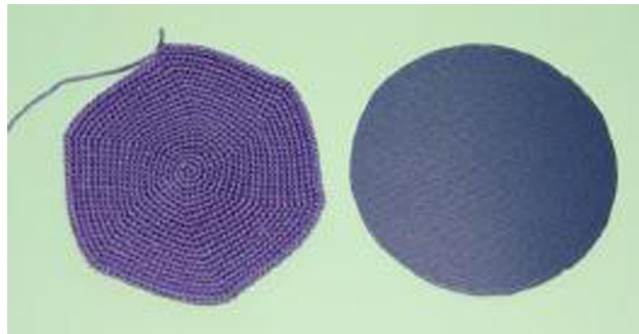
With Purple

Row 1: MR, 6 SC (6)
Row 2: 2 SC in each st (12)
Row 3: SC, Inc (Repeat) (18)
Row 4: 2 SC, Inc (Repeat) (24)
Row 5: 3 SC, Inc (Repeat) (30)
Row 6: 4 SC, Inc (Repeat) (36)
Row 7: 5 SC, Inc (Repeat) (42)
Row 8: 6 SC, Inc (Repeat) (48)
Row 9: 7 SC, Inc (Repeat) (54)
Row 10: 8 SC, Inc (Repeat) (60)
Row 11: 9 SC, Inc (Repeat) (66)
Row 12: 10 SC, Inc (Repeat) (72)
Row 13: 11 SC, Inc (Repeat) (78)
Row 14: 12 SC, Inc (Repeat) (84)
Row 15: 13 SC, Inc (Repeat) (90)

Trace piece onto thick card and cut it.

Row 22: BLO, 19 SC, Dec (repeat) (120)
Row 23: 18 SC, Dec (repeat) (114)
Row 24: SC (114)
Row 25: 17 SC, Dec (repeat) (108)
Row 26: SC (108)
Row 27: 16 SC, Dec (repeat) (102)
Row 28: SC (102)
Row 29: 15 SC, Dec (repeat) (96)
Row 30: SC (96)
Row 31: 14 SC, Dec (repeat) (90)
Row 32: SC (90)
Row 33: 13SC, Dec (repeat) (84)

Fasten off, leave tail for sewing.



Join Yellow/Gold on the unused loops of row 22
Row 1: 20 Sc, Inc (repeat) (132) As before on
The fringe do a RACHY Step all the way around,
Fasten off & weave in the ends.

Pink Decorations (Make 7)

Row 1: Ch 8, SC in 2nd chain from Hook & the Next 5 (6 In total) 3 SC in the last chain, and 6 down the other side of the chain,

Row 2: Ch1,7 Sc, 3 SC in next stitch then 7 down the other side

Row 3: Ch1,8 Sc, 3 SC in next stitch then 8 down the other side

Row 4: Ch1,9 Sc, 3 SC in next stitch then 9 down the other side

Fasten off & leave a tail for sewing.



Blue Decorations (Make 7)

Row 1: Chain 12, HDC in 3rd Chain from Hook & next 5 (6 in total) SC, in next 3 stitches ending with 3 SC in Starting CH. Working down the other side of the chain continue with 3 more SC ending with 6 HDC in each stitch. Fasten off leave a tail for sewing.

Sew the pieces to the foot, with a darker purple embroider detail in the centre of each of the pink pieces. Stuff the Foot and attach it to the head.



Nose

Row 1: With white, Make a MR with 6 SC pull closed (6)
Row 2: 2 SC in each Stitch (12)
Row 3: SC, Inc (repeat) (18)
Row 4: 2 SC, Inc (repeat) (24)
Row 5: 3 SC, Inc (repeat) (30)
Row 6: 4 SC, Inc (repeat) (36)
Row 7: 5 SC, Inc (repeat) (42)
Row 8: 6 SC, Inc (repeat) (48)
Row 9: BLO sc (48)
Row 10-11: SC (48)
Row 12: 24 HDC, 5 SC, Dec, 4 sc, Dec 4 SC, Dec, 5 SC (45)
Row 13: 24 HDC, 5 SC, 11 SS, 5 SC (45)
Row 14: SC, 24 HDC, 20 SC (45)
Row 15: SC, 24 HDC 5 SC, 11 SS, 4 SC (45)
Row 16: 2 SC, 23 HDC, 5 SC, Dec, 3 sc, Dec, 3 SC, Dec, 3 SC (42)
Row 17: 2 SC, 23 HDC, 5 SC, 11 SS, 2SC (42)
Row 18: 3 SC, 23 HDC, 16 SC (42)
Row 19: 3 SC 23 HDC, 4 SC, 11 SS, 1 SC (42)
Row 20: 4 SC, 23 HDC, 4 SC, Dec, 2 SC, Dec, 2 SC, Dec, SC (39)
Row 21: 4 SC, 23 HDC, 4SC, 8 SS (39)
Row 22: 5 SC, 23 HDC, 11 SC (39)
Row 23: SS, 4 SC, 23 HDC, 4 SC, 7 SS (39)
Row 24: Dec, 4 SC, 23 HDC, 4 SC, Dec, SC, Dec, SC (36)
Row 25: 3 SS, 3 SC, 23 HDC, 3 SC, 4 SS (23)
Row 26: 10 SC, 15 HDC, 11 SC
Row 27: BLO 4 SC, Dec (repeat) (30)

Change to Grey

Row 28: 3 SC, Dec (repeat) (24)
Row 29: 2 SC, Dec (repeat) (18)

Again the pattern calls for you to start stuffing here but I would do it as you crochet as the opening will be quite small and make it difficult to get a good firm stuffing.

Row 30: SC, Dec (repeat) (12)
Row 31: DC to close up.

Join white on the unused loops of row 27 SC all around and fasten off (36)

Sew the Spout/Nose to the head.



Chin

Row 1: With White make a MR with 6 SC, Pull closed (6)

Row 2: 2 SC in each stitch (12)

Row 3: SC, Inc (repeat) (18)

Row 4: 2 SC, Inc (repeat) (24)

Row 5: 3 SC, Inc (repeat) (30)

Row 6: 4 SC, Inc (repeat) (36)

Row 7: 10 SS, 3 SC, 20 HDC, 3 SC (36)

Row 8: 3 SC, Dec (repeat twice) 3 HDC in next stitch, HDC & SC in next, 18 SC, SC & HDC in Next stitch, 3 HDC, 2 sc (40)

Row 9: 2 SC, Dec (repeat twice) 3 HDC in next stitch, HDC & SC in next, 24 SC, SC & HDC in Next stitch, 3 HDC, 2 sc (44)

Row 10: 5 SS

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing. Sew the Chin a few rows under the Nose/Spout to leave a gap for the lips



Lips

Row 1: With Red Chain 12, SS in 2nd chain from Hook, SC, HDC & SC, In next stitch 2 DC & 1 SC, SS, HDC & SC in Next Stitch, SC, HDC, SC, SS,

Continue crocheting on the other side of the chain

Row: 2 SS, SC, HDC, DC, DC, TR in next 3 St, DC, HDC, SC, SS,
Fasten off with a tail for sewing and sew the lips in the gap between the Spout & Chin

Eye Ball

Row 1: With white yarn, Chain 10, SC in 2nd Ch from hook and the next 7 stitches ending with 3 SC in the starting chain, SC 8 down the other side of the chain. (19)

Row 2: Ch 1, 8 SC, Inc, (repeat 3 times) 8 SC, turn (22)

Row 3: Ch 1, 8 SC, (SC, Inc repeat 3 times) 8 SC turn (25)

Row 4: SS, Ch 1, SC, 8 HDC, 2 HDC in next stitch, 2 HDC, 2 HDC in next stitch, 2 HDC, 2 HDC in next stitch, 6 HDC, SC, SS, Turn (28)

Row 5: CH 1, 2 SS, 2 SC, 9 HDC, 2 HDC in next stitch, 2 HDC in next stitch, 9 HDC, 2 SC, 2 SS, Inc, 7 SC,



Change to Black

Row 6: BLO SC around for the outline.

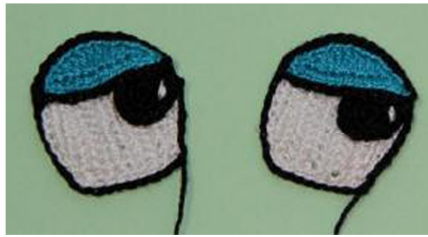
Eye Lid

Row 1: With Blue Yarn, Ch 14 SS into 2nd chain from hook, 2 sc, HDC, 2 SC, 3 Tr in next stitch, 2 SC, DC, 2 DC, SS, 12 SC along the bottom of the chain.

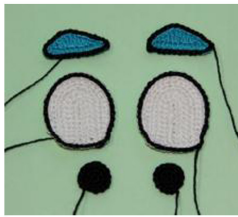
Change to Black BLO SC all around.

Pupil

Row 1: With Black yarn MR, 6 SC (12)
Row 2: 2 SC in each stitch (12)
Row 3: 3 SC, Inc (repeat) (15)
Fasten off, Leave tail for sewing.



Sew the eyelids to the eyeball and after the pupil. Embroider with white thread the reflection in the pupil. Sew the eyes above the nose. Embroider eyelashes, eyebrows and wrinkles around the eyes and nose with black thread.



Shaping

Insert the needle and the thread in the top part of the chin up to coming to the internal corner of the eye and stretch lightly. Bring the needle and yarn back down from the bottom corner of the eye to the chin and stretch again Do this along 2-3 rows squeezing the eyes and chin, hide the thread inside the body



Lid Handle

- Row 1: With Yellow/Gold yarn, Leave a long tail for sewing, MR, 6 SC
- Row 2: 2 SC in each stitch (12)
- Row 3: 3 SC, Inc (repeat) (15)
- Row 4: BLO SC
- Row 5-6: SC (15)

(This part is a little tricky, I had a hard time translating it and I'm sorry to say I'm not sure its correct I will include the diagram for you so you might be able to figure it out if I am wrong.)



The next set of stitches create the "leaf" motif along the top of the Lid handle and is worked into the un-used front loops of Row 4.

- Row 7: Chain 4, work 3 DC into chain, Repeat 5 times to create the decoration once 5 "frills" have been made Change to Pink.
- Row 8: 2 SC, Inc (repeat) (20)
- Row 9: 3 SC, Inc (repeat) (25)
- Row 10: SC (25)
- Row 11: 3 SC, Dec (repeat) (20)
- Row 12: 2 SC, Dec (repeat) (15)



Stuff the lid handle and continue to Crochet

- Row 13: SC, Dec (repeat) (10)
- Row 14: Dec until the top is closed

Snip the yarn and hide it in the handle. Sew the lid handle to the lid and Colour the cheeks with a light dusting of blush.



Teapot Handle

Row 1: In Gold/Yellow Create a MR, with 6 SC & pull closed (6)

Row 2: 2 SC in each stitch (12)

Row 3: SC, Inc (repeat) (18)

Row 4: 2 SC, Inc (repeat) (24)

Row 5: 3 SC, Inc (repeat) (30)

Row 6 – 10: SC (30)

Row 11: 8 SC, Dec (repeat) (27)

Row 12: 7 SC, Dec (repeat) (24)

Row 13: 6 SC, Dec (repeat) (21)

Row 14: 5 SC, Dec (repeat) (18)

Row 15 – 94: SC (18)

Fasten off leave tail for sewing



Cut a length of wire slightly longer than the handle and wrap it with Stuffing and then with yarn, insert the wrapped wire into the handle. Insert the excess wire into the body and sew the handle in place at the bottom first then the top bending it into shape as you sew.



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Chip



Head

In white yarn & with a no 1'25 hook

Row 1: With white make a MR with 6 SC pull closed (6)
Row 2: 2 SC in each stitch (12)
Row 3: SC, Inc (repeat) (18)
Row 4: 2 SC, Inc (repeat) (24)
Row 5: 7 SC, Inc (repeat) (27)
Row 6: BLO SC (27)
Row 7: 8 SC, Inc (repeat) (30)
Row 8: 4 SC, Inc (repeat) (36)
Row 9: 5 SC, Inc (repeat) (42)
Row 10: 6 SC, Inc (repeat) (48)
Row 11: 7 SC, Inc (repeat) (54)
Row 12: 8 SC, Inc (repeat) (60)
Row 13 – 18: SC (60)
Row 19: 9 SC, Inc (repeat) (66)
Row 20: SC around (66)

There are two ways to do this next part, The original pattern calls for you to fasten off at the end of row 20, Rejoin the yarn one stitch over and SC 64, repeating this step 5 times for a total of 6 rows, Alternatively for less hassle you can do the following

Row 21-26: Ch, Turn SC 64 (this will create the chip in the cup)

Measure up and cut the plastic bottle to size



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Row 31: SC (60)
 Row 32: 59 SC, Dec (60)
 Row 33-36: SC (60)
 Row 37: 8 SC, Dec (repeat) (54)
 Row 38: SC (54)
 Row 39: 7 SC, Dec (repeat) (48)
 Row 40: 48 SC (48)
 Row 41: 6 SC, Dec (repeat) (42)
 Row 42: 5 SC, Dec (repeat) (36)
 Row 43: 4 SC, Dec (repeat) (30)
 Row 44: SC (30)
 Row 45: 3 SC, Dec (repeat) (24)
 Row 46: 2 SC, Dec (repeat) (18)
 Row 47: SC, Dec (repeat) (12)
 Row 48: Dec until closed.
 Fasten off with a long tail for sewing.



If you have not already, cut a chip out of the plastic bottle to match up with the chip in the cup. Stitch around the edge of the "chip to close up the gap so no plastic is showing. Join Gold/Yellow at round 26 (the top of the cup) and do a Step Rchy around the edge (as you did on Mrs Potts, There is a link to a tutorial further up the pattern.



Foot

Row 1: Attach Yellow/Gold at Row 6 of the Cup SC 27 around (27)

Change to Purple

Row 2: BLO 8 SC, Inc (repeat) (30)
 Row 3: 4 SC, Inc (repeat) (36)
 Row 4: SC (36)
 Row 5: 5 SC, Inc (repeat) (42)
 Row 6: 6 SC, Inc (repeat) (48)
 Row 7: 7 SC, Inc (repeat) (54)
 Row 8: 8 SC Inc (repeat) (60)
 Row 9: SC (60)



Join Gold/Yellow and Step Rchy around the end, fasten off hide tail.

Foot Decorations

Blue Decorations (make 5)

Row 1: Chain 10, SC in 2nd Ch from Hook & next 7 for a total of 8, 3 SC in next stitch and 8 SC down the other side of the chain Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.



Magenta Decorations (make 5)

Row 1: Chain 8, SC in 2nd chain from hook and Next 5 for a total of 6, 3 SC in last Ch then 6 SC down the other side of the chain (15)

Row 2: Ch & Turn, 7 SC, 3 SC in same stitch, 7 SC (17)

Row 3: Ch & Turn, 8 SC, 3 SC in Same Stitch, 8 SC (19)

Fasten off Leave a tail for sewing.

Sew the Decorations to the Foot in alternating colours.



Eyes (make 2 of each part)

Eyeball

Row 1: With white Chain 6, SC in 2nd chain from hook and next 3 for 4 stitch, 3 SC in last chain, 3 SC down the other side ending with 2 SC in last stitch. (12)

Row 2: Chain, 4 SC, 3 sc in next St, (4 SC, Inc repeat twice) (17)

Row 3: SC, Inc, 3 sc, 3 SC in next stitch, 5 SC, (SC, Inc repeat twice) (22)

Row 4: 2 SC, Inc, 6 sc, 3 sc In next stitch, 6 SC (2 SC, Inc repeat twice) (27)

Row 5: Change to black in BLO SC around (27)

Pupil

Row 1: In Black, MR, 6 SC

Row 2: 2 SC in each stitch (12)

Row 3: 3 SC, Inc (repeat) (15)

Fasten off, leave tail for sewing.



Nose

Row 1: In Gold/Yellow, MR, 6 SC
Row 2 – 4: 6 SC
Row 5: 5 SC, Inc (7)
Row 6: 7 SC (7)
Row 7: 6 SC, Inc (8)
Row 8: 8 SC (8)
Row 9: 7 SC, Inc (9)
Row 10: 9 SC (9)
Row 11: 8 SC, Inc (10)

Stuff loosely

Row 12-22: 10 SC (10)
Row 23: Dec until closed

Leave a tail for sewing.

Sew the pupils to the eyes and use white yarn to embroider a highlight in the pupil.
Sew the eyes and nose to the cup and embroider the face details,
Use a Red/Pink marker to make chips tounge.
